

Information Technology Auditor – Beaumont, Texas

The Texas State University System is seeking an Information Technology Auditor for its four Lamar campuses in Texas. Located in Beaumont, Texas, this position affords an excellent opportunity to recommend improvements on systems running on multiple servers functioning in various departments in all four institutions. You will interact with all levels of IT and general management, and utilize some of the latest technology. Continuing education is strongly encouraged, and there are many opportunities for career progression within the Texas State University System in Beaumont and elsewhere. Within easy reach of Houston, Beaumont is an excellent place to live and work. This position reports directly to the Director of the Office of Audits and Analysis-Lamar Campuses.

QUALIFICATIONS

Applicants should have at least four years experience in IT auditing, information systems implementation, or network security design, and have a four-year degree in a related subject, such as computer science. Relevant certifications are very desirable, including, but not limited to, CIA, CISA, CISSP, or MCSE. In-depth knowledge of Oracle, Windows XP, Windows 7, the SunGard Banner system, TeamMate, ACL or IDEA are advantages. Experience working with state, federal, and industry requirements (such as HIPAA, PCI, TAC202 etc) would be useful. Interpersonal and communications skills are very important for this position.

JOB DESCRIPTION

The IT auditor independently plans and performs IT audits to determine whether controls over automated systems protect confidential student, academic, financial and operational data from unauthorized use, access, manipulation, or loss; whether the IT infrastructure is protected from loss or damage; whether disaster recovery plans and precautions enable recovery from disasters in a timely manner; and whether the governance, risk assessment, and control processes ensure the production of reliable and timely data and compliance with all applicable laws and procedures. There will also be opportunities to work on other types of reviews, such as operational, financial, or compliance audits.

The auditor will conduct risk assessments, develop and use work programs, obtain relevant information by computerized means and by interviews, prepare electronic work paper documentation, and make detailed recommendations for improvement to management. Work is performed according to the International standards for the Professional Practice of Internal Auditing and Government Auditing Standards.

Salary is commensurate with the successful applicant's experience and qualifications. Benefits include medical and dental insurance, sick leave, paid vacation, retirement benefits, and other benefits available to State of Texas employees.
